French Woods is now offering a wonderful opportunity for the siblings, friends, and relatives of our French Woods family. We are inviting boys and girls ages 7 to 12 who are interested in registering for French Woods to "test the waters." It is an opportunity for your children to spend a weekend at French Woods, to get a taste of what would be in store for them. (Should you sign your children up for camp, your \$100 registration fee may be applied to future camp tuition.)

Parents drop their children off at 10:00 AM on Saturday, June 17th. You will be treated to a bagel brunch and a tour of the facility, as well as a question and answer period with one of our directors. At the same time your children will be escorted to their bunks, where they will be placed in cabins with their own counselors. Once settled, the "mini-campers" will be immersed into the French Woods program. On Saturday, they will take part in two activities before lunch and three activities before dinner.

Saturday night will be filled with special evening activity events including a make-your-own sundae and pizza social topped off with the music of our terrific DJ. Longtime French Woods Family member Brian Kite is returning to French Woods this summer during session 3. He is currently the Chair of the UCLA School of Theater, Film and Television Department of Theater and has directed across the United States and abroad. He served as Producing Artistic Director of La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts from 2008-2015.

While talking to Beth Schaefer this winter, Brian said, that in his experience, French Woods campers who apply to UCLA often stand out because they know what to do in an audition room.

Important Online Forms & Documents

It is not too soon to get started on your camp forms regardless of which session(s) your child(ren) are registered for!

All forms and documents are now accessible online. The forms you submit online become attached automatically to your child's file. Please, please help us by getting this done timely. Fill out your Bunk Requests NOW!

ONLINE INSTRUCTIONS: Please go to frenchwoods.com and in the upper right hand corner, click on **CAMPIN TOUCH**. From there you will enter the parent email address that we have on file for you. If you have not yet had the chance to sign into CampIn Touch or if you forgot your password, click on **retrieve/set password**. Once you get your password, you will be directed to your **Forms Dashboard**. Click on **Forms and Documents** and there you will see two types of forms - the ones with a **barcode icon must be printed out**, filled in and signed by either the physician and/or parent. The Registration, Physician's Exam, Health Care Provider OTC's, Parent Medical Authorization and Meningitis Vaccination forms are all forms to be printed out. Once completed and signed, you can fax them back to the designated faxback number on the bottom of the forms (845) 468-7078. Alternatively, you can scan the completed/signed forms into your

computer and upload each from your dashboard. (It is important that you use only the faxback number to faxback.)

The other type of forms has a **computer monitor icon**. Those are all **web-based forms and can be filled in online**. The Application, Bunk Requests, Transportation, Health History, Immunizations, Activity Preference and Verification forms are all web-based forms.

Below the Forms and Documents for your camper you will find **Forms and Documents for Your Family**. There you will find important information including a **Camper Guide** and a separate **Parent Guide**. Additionally there is a list of nearby accommodations and a suggested packing list and information about **CampMeds**. If your child takes medication, New York state requires individual packaging of all meds. CampMeds can help you take care of this requirement. Please note that no child will be admitted to camp without a completed medical form signed by your physician. In addition all immunizations must be documented. These are New York State Health Department rules which we must abide by.

VISITING 2016

Visiting days are **June 24th** and **25th**, **July 14th** and **15th**, **August 3th** and **4th** and **August 24th** and **25th**. Visiting is held from 1:30PM on the first day and from 10AM on the second day, both through evening performances. Session 5 visiting day begins at 10AM on **September 2nd** and concludes after dinner.

There is **NO** visiting prior to these times. Parents are welcome to have meals with us during these times. **Picnic meals, homemade care packages or any other outside food may NOT be brought into camp**. (This includes pizzas, ice cream, McDonalds and any other food that may be purchased in town). Under no circumstances may a child leave camp. Concerts, circus and performances of shows will take place on these mornings, afternoons and evenings along with all scheduled activities. Remember, **NO PETS** on camp.

These dates represent our only visiting times. Any other visitation must be arranged in advance. Call the camp office if special arrangements need to be made.

It is our hope that you will see your children enjoying activities and performances with a minimum of disruption to their daily routine.

Second Session Shows 2018***

Snow White (7 - 9 year olds)

After her jealous stepmother, the Queen, tries to have her killed, Snow White runs away into the forest, where she finds refuge with seven kindly dwarfs. The years pass but when the Queen discovers Snow White is still alive, she attempts to destroy her rival with the help of clever disguises and a poisoned apple..

Charlotte's Web (7 - 9 year olds)

This exciting, new musical version of Charlotte's Web brings a new dimension to E.B. White's beloved classic. With music and lyrics by Charles Strouse (Annie, 'Bye, 'Bye Birdie) and book by Joseph Robinette (national award-winning children's playwright) This joyous musical offers your audiences a very special experience.

Prince of Egypt (9 - 11 year olds)

The Prince of Egypt tells the story of Moses with over a dozen songs from the beloved animated film. Songs from The Prince of Egypt were written by composer and lyricist Stephen Schwartz, well known for writing the Broadway musical smash hit, Wicked. Songs include "Deliver Us," "When You Believe," "All I Ever Wanted," "Through Heaven's Eyes," and "Playing With the Big Boys Now."

Knuffle Bunny (9 - 11 year olds)

Girl loves stuffed animal. Girl loses beloved animal. Girl fights to get animal back. Based on the beloved Caldecott Honor-winning picture book, Knuffle Bunny: A Cautionary Musical is filled with adventure, song and dancing laundry and an instant children's classic!

Dr Doolittle (9 - 11 year olds)

The musical tells the classic tale of a wacky but kind Doctor who can talk to animals. The show takes the audience on a journey from the small English village of Puddleby-on-the-Marsh to the far corners of the world.

Dear Edwina (9 - 11 year olds)

Follow Edwina Spoonapple as she directs the kids in the neighborhood in production number after hilarious production number in her "Advice-A-Palooza" extravaganza.

Where's Charlie (11 - 12 year olds)

Oxford University students Charley and Jack invite the young and winsome Kitty and Amy to lunch under the chaperoning eye of Donna Lucia, Charley's wealthy aunt (it is, after all, 1892). But when Donna Lucia doesn't show, a desperate Charley disguises himself as his aunt so the young ladies can visit, unaware they've brought a chaperon of their own: Amy's stuffy uncle, who promptly falls for Charley's aunt-like charms! Then the real aunt shows up, and it's all downhill from there: quick changes, fast talking, marriage proposals, compromising situations and rowdy hilarity.

Sister Act * (11 - 14 year olds)

Sister Act is the feel-amazing musical comedy smash based on the 1992 hit film. When disco diva Deloris Van Cartier witnesses a murder, she is put in protective custody in one place the cops are sure she won't be a found: a convent!

Joseph and the Amazing... (11 - 14 year olds)

Andrew Lloyd webber and Tim Rice have created a soft -rock fantasy from the biblical story of Joseph and his brethren and turned this ancient tale into a rollicking pastiche of vaudevillian turns, country and western, calypso and 50's rock and roll.

42nd Street * (11 - 14 year olds)

A big, bold musical set in 1933 that celebrates the stuff that dreams are made of. The ultimate backstage musical has many hit tunes and some of the greatest production numbers in musical theatre.

James and The Giant Peach (11-14 year olds)

This is a wonderful & amazing adaptation of Ronald Dahl's classic book. The story as you many know, tells of James and how his wish to get away from his evil aunts comes true in the form of a giant peach.

13 (11 - 14 year olds)**

13 is a musical with lyrics and music by Jason Robert Brown and a book by Dan Elish, with Robert Horn. The story concerns the life of 13-year-old Evan Goldman as he moves from New York City to Appleton, Indiana, and his dilemma when the move conflicts with the celebration of his Bar mitzvah.

Little Women (11-17 year olds)

Based on Louisa May Alcott's life, Little Women follows the adventures of sisters, Jo, Meg, Beth and Amy March. Jo is trying to sell her stories for publication, but the publishers are not interested – her friend, Professor Bhaer, tells her that she has to do better and write more from herself. Taking this advice, Jo weaves the story of herself and her sisters and their experience growing up in Civil War America.

Wonderful Town * (11 - 17 year olds)

Two sisters from Ohio? One is smart, one is pretty? Come to 1930's New York, hoping to hit the big time. With colorful Greenwich village neighbors, job-hunting adventures and a conga line of dancing sailors, things are never dull.
